

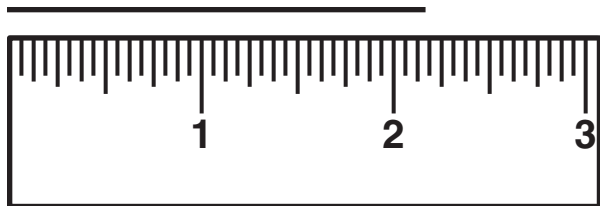

Measure with Customary and Metric Units

Customary units include units such as inches, feet, yards, and miles.
Metric units include units such as centimeter, meter, and kilometer.



Example: What is the length of the segment shown to the nearest eighth of an inch?

Answer: The smallest tick mark represents $\frac{1}{16}$ of an inch. The line segment is slightly to the left of the $\frac{3}{16}$ mark, so the segment is $2\frac{1}{8}$ inch long, to the nearest eighth of an inch.
