| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Acute | Less than $90^{\circ}$ | B• | $\angle A B C$ or $\angle C B A$ |
| Right | $90^{\circ}$ |  | $\angle D E F$ or $\angle F E D$ |
| Obtuse | Greater than $90^{\circ}$ |  | $\angle P Q R$ or $\angle R Q P$ |
| Straight | $180^{\circ}$ | $\underset{\leftarrow}{X} \quad Y \quad \underset{\bullet}{Z}$ | $\angle X Y Z$ or $\angle Z Y X$ |
